Tannat 2020

May began with the bottling of our Tannat vintage 2020. This French variety has left a significant mark on wine regions across the Americas, notably Uruguay, Argentina, and the USA. After aging for 24 months in American oak barrels, this Tannat has developed a rich structure and outstanding flavors of blackberries, cedar, and dried plums. We have added a touch of Syrah to balance its bold and tannic structure. Enjoy this complex and full-bodied wine crafted with grapes grown in Clarksburg, California. This wine will be released to our club members on July 1st, 2024.

Frutoso Frizzante

During May, we bottled a new batch of our Frutoso Frizzante. This delightful wine draws inspiration from the classic Spanish Sangria. Utilizing vibrant fruits and a playful fizz, we have created a nicely balanced wine with sweet fruity flavors and a hint of tart sparkle. This summer wine bursts with aromas and flavors of maraschino cherries, cranberries, peach syrup, and lemonade. Enjoy this wine with fresh fruits, and appetizers, and as a delightful addition to your summer cocktails.

Sangria Rouge

Throughout May, we pleasantly blended and bottled a new batch of our Sangria Rouge in various bottle sizes. Now you can savor the exquisite flavors of cherries, peaches, cranberries, and orange juice by uncorking a 750 ml bottle or twisting off a 375 ml screw cap.

GSM 2021

During the final weeks of May, we blended and bottled our inaugural GSM blend! GSM is a classic blend originating from the Côtes du Rhône region of France and is now produced across diverse wine-grape-growing regions worldwide. It comprises three grapes: Grenache, Syrah, and Mourvèdre. Grenache contributes fruitiness and juiciness, Syrah adds depth and complexity, and Mourvèdre enriches with richness and structure. This elegant trio of grapes creates a wine that displays juicy flavors and a complex profile. Our 2021 Lynfred GSM exhibits elegant and distinctive aromas and flavors of dried sage, herbs, cherry, vanilla, and oak. It is a versatile wine, perfect for pairing with Mediterranean cuisine or for sipping to unwind and relax. This wine will be released to our club members on August 1st, 2024. Cheers!

Black Muscat 2023

Concluding our cellar efforts for the month, we bottled a new addition to our white wine portfolio: a crisp and refreshing Black Muscat vintage 2023. This variety, also known as Muscat of Hamburg, features pink skin and is cultivated in many European countries for consumption as fresh fruit or for wine production. The grapes were hand-picked from vineyards in Lodi, California. Following a gentle crushing process, the juice was immediately drained to obtain a clean yellow juice with subtle coral hues. Fermentation took place at low temperatures to preserve the aromas and flavors of the variety. Our Lynfred Black Muscat exhibits aromas and flavors of flowers, honeysuckle, and peaches. It is an ideal choice for those who appreciate a light, fruity wine with a floral touch on a warm summer evening. Cheers!
